Academic Progress:

- Most importantly, at **School-On-Wheels (SOW)**, we are striving to integrate the **"Apni Mitti Se Judi Shiksha"** rural, skill-based curriculum—ensuring that children learn **mainstream academic subjects alongside practical, livelihood-oriented skills**.
- Regular computer classes are being conducted on our School-On-Wheels (SOW) buses to ensure digital literacy for all our students. This year, **10 students** are preparing to appear for the **NIIT certification exam**—a significant step toward their future readiness.
- Madhyamik Success: Over the years, **25 students** from our School-On-Wheels (SOW) program have **successfully cleared the Madhyamik examination**. This year, **one more student** appeared and passed with commendable marks, continuing the legacy of perseverance and achievement.

Mallickpur : Total students -315 (AY 2025 – 2026)

- **Madhyamik Success:** All **eight students** from Mallickpur School who appeared for the **Madhyamik examination passed with flying colors**—a proud moment for our school.

- **The Rural School at Mallickpur** offers regular computer classes, fostering digital literacy among all its students. This marks a significant step forward in their academic and career journeys.
- Enrichment classes in **swimming, music, singing and other co-curricular activities** are conducted every **Friday and Saturday**, nurturing the holistic development of our students.

Children are now aware of the difference between perishable and non-perishable waste and are actively using green and blue bins accordingly. They are also learning how to create compost pits, promoting sustainable waste management practices from a young age.

Students are learning to confidently operate computers and apply their skills through hands-on projects and practical assignments.

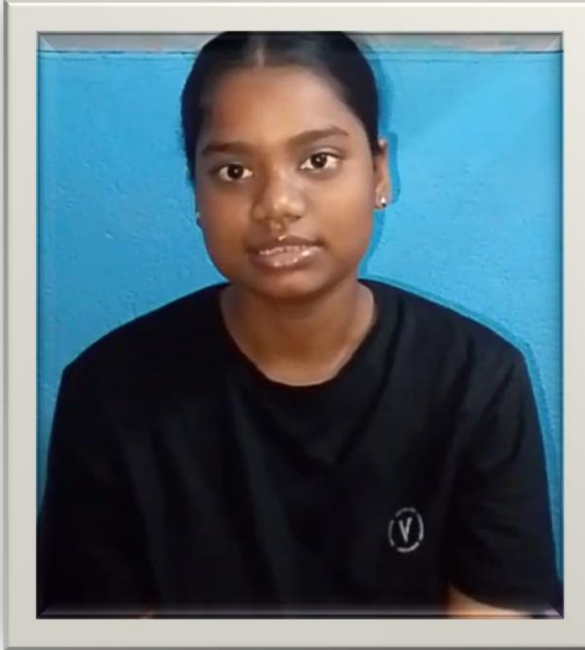
Pottery classes are being conducted to train the students to make clay utensils and diyas.
